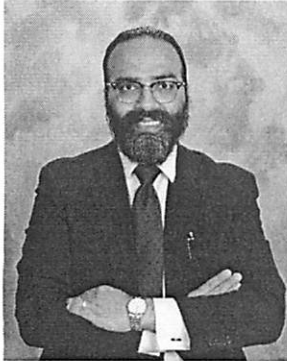


Gurpreet Singh Bio
